I understand that Freedom Blue PPO will notify me in writing of my confirmed effective date of enrollment in Freedom Blue PPO. I understand that, typically, my effective date will be the first of the month following the month in which Freedom Blue PPO receives my <u>completed</u> enrollment application. I understand that I may want to consider not cancelling any Medicare supplement plan or Medigap/Medicare Select plan until I am notified in writing of my confirmed effective date in Freedom Blue PPO.

Highmark Senior Solutions Company is a PPO plan with a Medicare contract. Enrollment in Highmark Senior Solutions Company depends on contract renewal.

Freedom Blue PPO is a Medicare Advantage plan and has a contract with the Federal government. I will need to keep my Medicare Parts A and Part B. I can be in only one Medicare Advantage plan at a time, and I understand that my enrollment in this plan will automatically end my enrollment in another Medicare health plan or prescription drug plan. It is my responsibility to inform you of any prescription drug coverage that I have or may get in the future. I understand that if I don't have Medicare prescription drug coverage, or creditable prescription drug coverage (as good as Medicare's), I may have to pay a late enrollment penalty if I enroll in Medicare prescription drug coverage in the future. If we determine that you owe a late enrollment penalty (or if you currently have a late enrollment penalty), we need to know how you would prefer to pay it. You can pay by mail or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) each month. You can also choose to pay your premium by automatic deduction from your Social Security or Railroad Retirement Board (RRB) benefit check each month. People with Limited Incomes may qualify for Extra Help to pay for their prescription drug costs. If eligible, Medicare could pay for 75% or more of your drug costs including monthly prescription drug premiums, annual deductibles, and co-insurance.
